All board members are expected to :

- Maintain current membership in our chapter, NAWIC Coastal Georgia #380

 - Board meetings will be the second Thursday of every month
 - Board members are committed to following the bylaws set by our chapter to not miss two board meetings in a row, rare exceptions are considered based on circumstance
- Contribute to setting and helping our chapter achieve our goals
- Make reasonable efforts to attend chapter events, including monthly business meetings, after hours events, special events, etc.
- Be a leader in creating a welcoming, warm and inclusive community for our members.
- Share events and happenings of our group to your social media and network, as appropriate for your personal brand.
- Report to the board on a committee of the local association, can be the leader of the committee but can also be involved and comfortable with reporting on activities.
- Use kind, direct communication to address issues of our local association.
